Mr. Muralidharan is registered to practice before the Bangalore High Court Patent Office and is registered with the Bar Council of India.

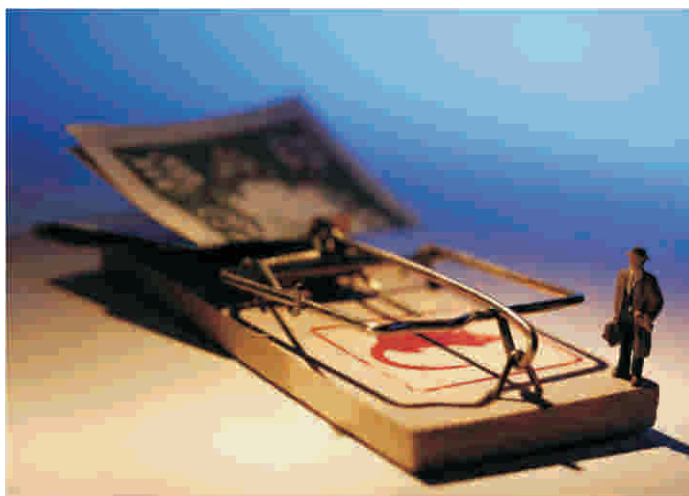
